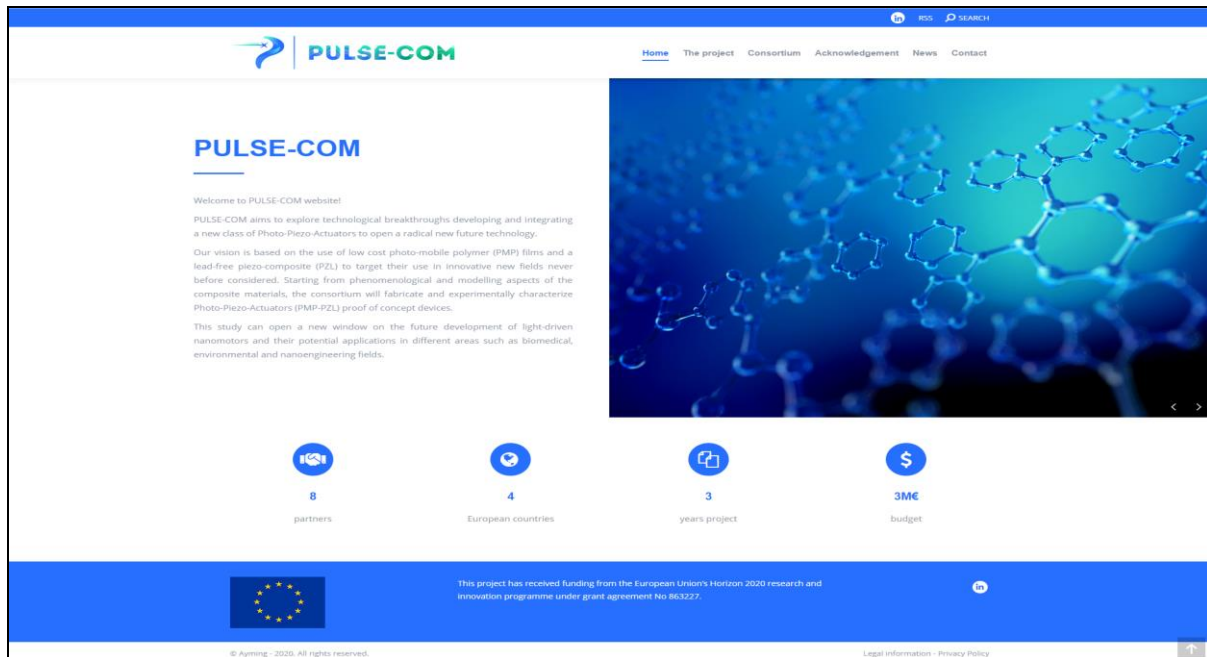


Figure 1: Homepage

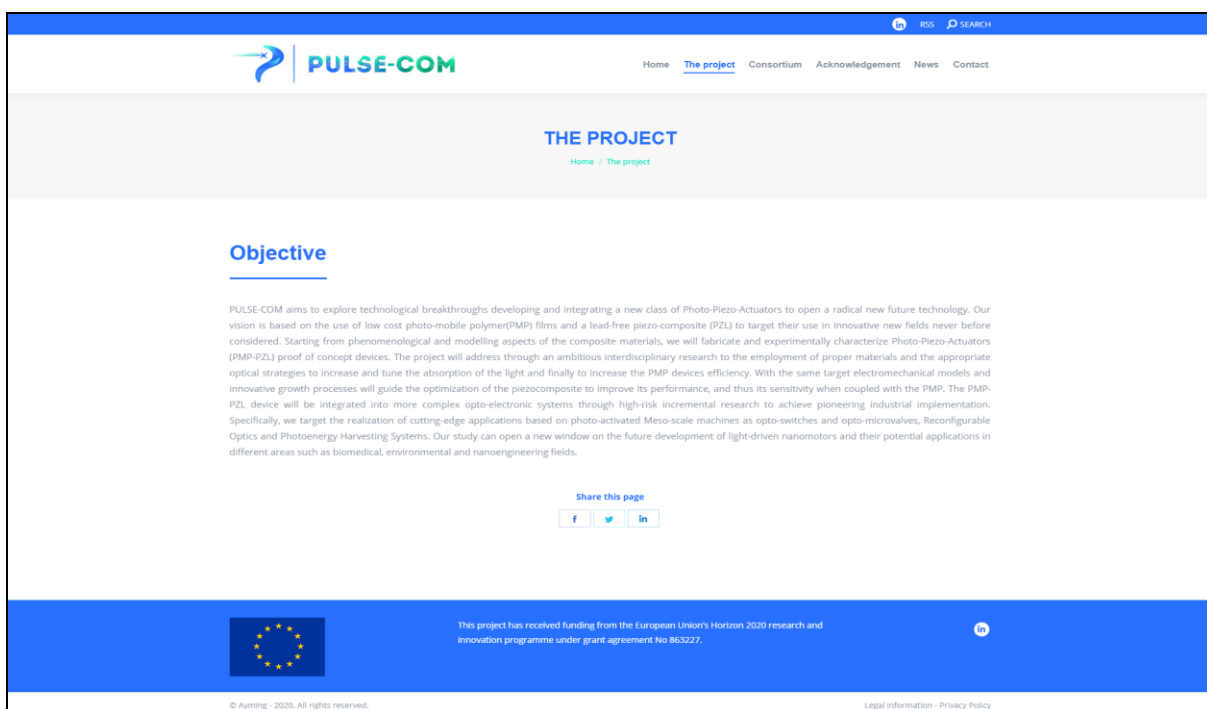


Figure 2: Objective

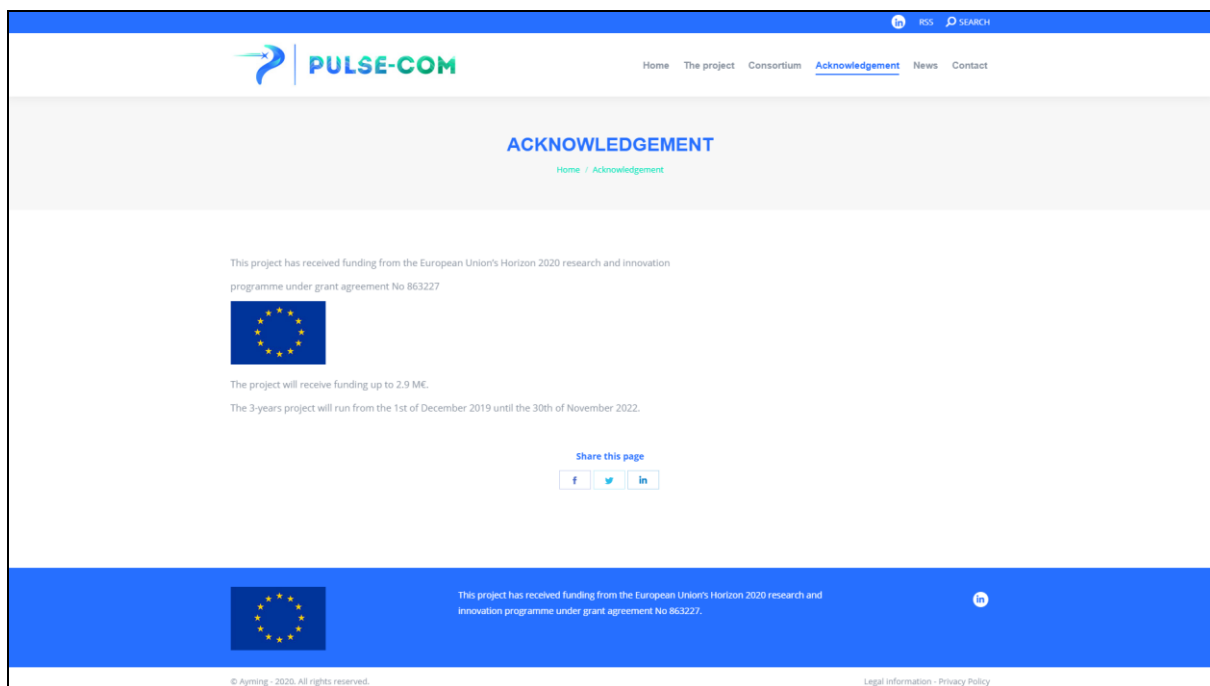


Figure 4: Acknowledgement



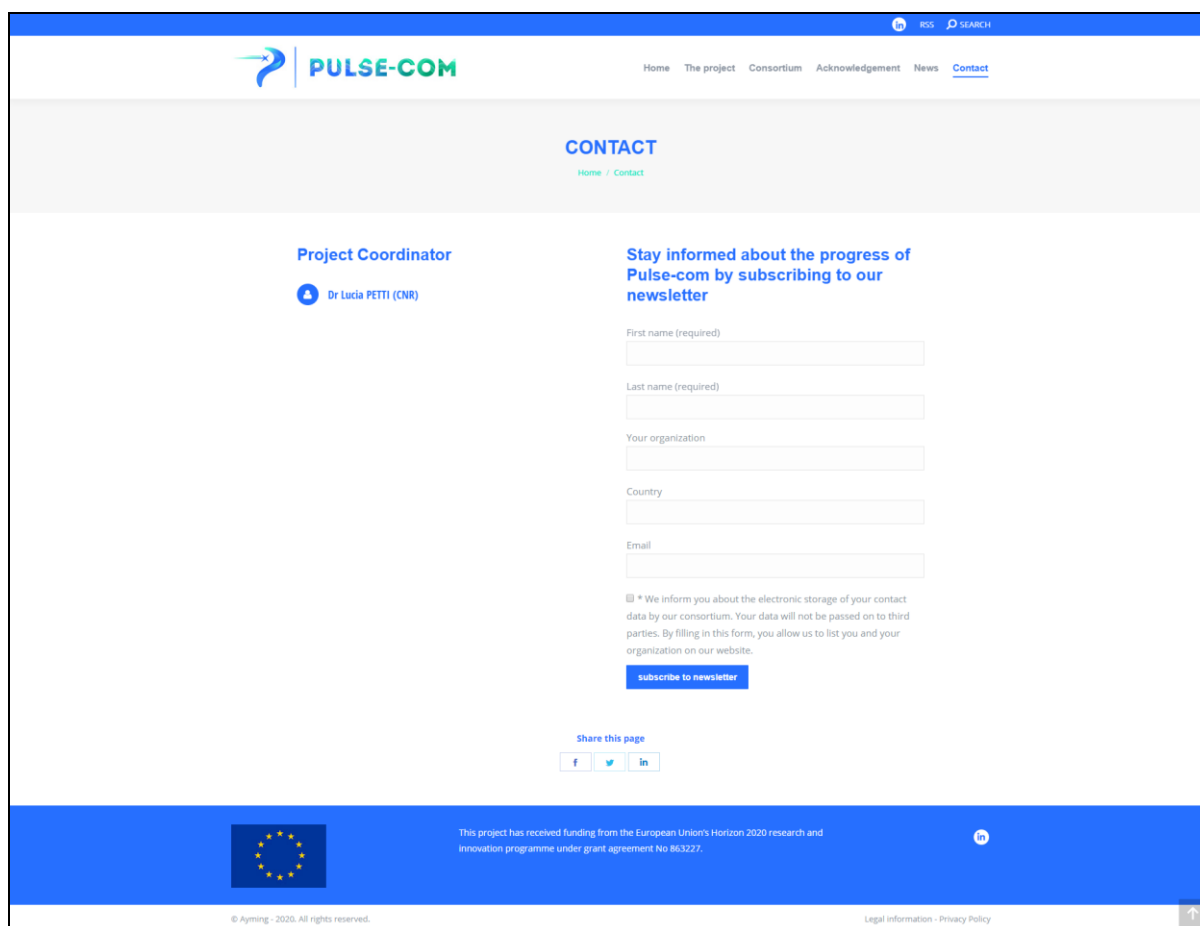


Figure 5: Contact
